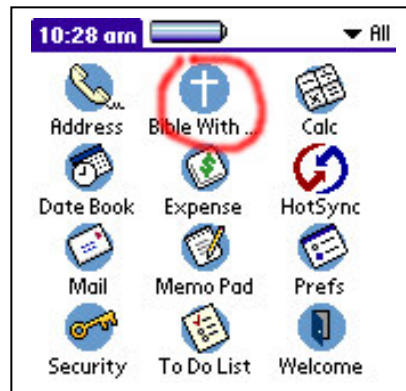

2 Start the application

Locate the **Bible With You** icon on the Applications screen of your Palm OS handheld. Launch the application by tapping on the icon.



3 Registration

3.1 Licenses

GMP Soft offers the following Licenses for using this product:

2. **Standard License** – Allows unlimited number of Licenses to be active at a time. A Standard License gives a permission to activate Bible With You from applications supporting Verse Show Protocol (for example Concordance With You).
3. **Limited License** – Allows only a single License to be active at a time. A Limited License does not give a permission to activate Bible With You from applications supporting Verse Show Protocol (for example Concordance With You).

3.2 Product registration

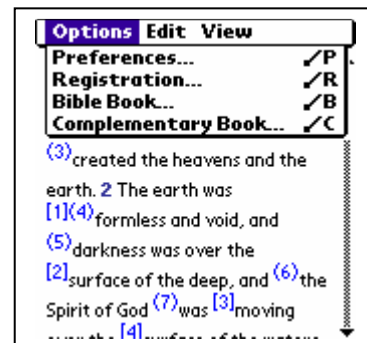
This fully functioning product requires an *Unlock Key* to skip the trial reminder. The *Unlock Key* is a hexadecimal number, for example AB12-CD34 that you receive upon the purchase of the product. You can purchase from our site: www.gmpsoft.com.

To register the product:

1. Choose **Registration** from the **Options** menu:
 - Tap on **Bible With You** bar or **Menu** button to display the form menu
 - Tap on **Options**
 - Tap on **Registration**

Or

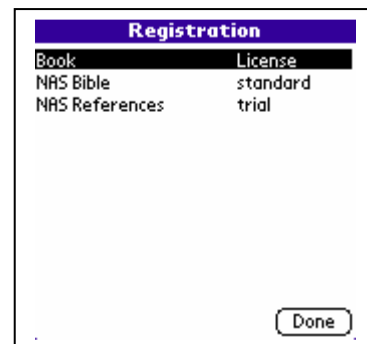
- Draw the *Graffiti Menu Command stroke* ✓ and the letter **R** on the silkscreen



2. Choose a product to register:
 - Tap on the **Trial** active field against the product

The License column indicates current license of a product:

- Standard – indicates a registered product
- Limited – indicates a limited product registration
- N/A – product is not available
- Disable – the product is not active
- Trial – indicates product is not registered

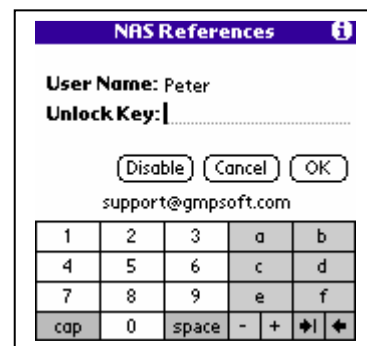


Note: The *Trial reminder* form will be displayed if there is even one product with a Trial License state.

3. Type the *Unlock Key* in the **Unlock Key** field:
 - Tap consequently on the corresponding buttons or use the System Keyboard
4. Confirm
 - Tap on **OK** button.

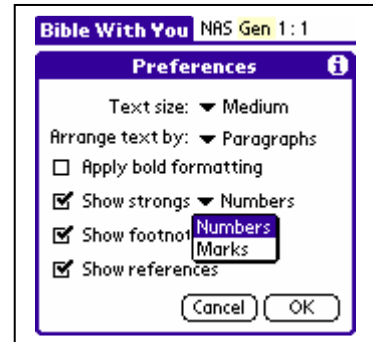
If you do not want to use a particular product, tap on **Disable**.

Note: *Disable* option is available only for Study Aid Products.



4 Preferences

1. Choose **Preferences** from the **Options** menu
 - Tap on **Bible With You** bar or **Menu** button to display the form menu
 - Tap on **Options**
 - Tap on **Preferences****Or**
 - Draw the *Graffiti Menu Command stroke* ✓ and the letter **P** on the silkscreen



2. Text size
 - Tap on the triangle button on the left of the **Text size** field
 - Choose text size from the drop down list
3. Arrange text by Paragraphs/Verses
 - Choose desired formatting from the list
4. Apply bold formatting to text
 - Enable **Apply Bold Formatting** check box

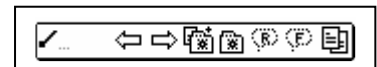
5. Show Strong's Numbers

Note: Strong's numbers feature is available only for bible translations that provide this information.

- Enable **Show Strong's** check box
 - Tap on the triangle button next to **Show Strong's** check box
 - Select **Numbers** or **Marks** from the drop-down list
6. Show/hide footnotes

Note: If this option is not enabled, footnotes will not be displayed in the text.

 - Tap on **Show footnotes** check box to change alternatively its state**Or**
 - Draw the *Graffiti Menu Command stroke* to display the command toolbar
 - Tap on **F** icon

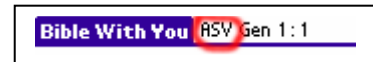


7. Confirm
 - Tap on **OK** button

5 Reading Bible Mode

5.1 Select Bible version

1. Open **Select Bible** form
 - Tap on the *Bible translation field* at the **Menu Bar****Or**
 - Tap on **Bible With You** bar or **Menu** button to display the menu
 - Tap on **Options**
 - Tap on **Bible Book****Or**
 - Draw the *Graffiti Menu Command stroke* ✓ and the letter **B** on the silkscreen



2. Scan for new Bible translations
 - Tap on **Scan**

Bible With You stores cache information about the available databases. This speeds the operation when you use memory cards.

It is not necessary to scan each time. Scan when you:

- Installed new bible(s)
- Deleted bible(s)
- Transferred bible(s) from handheld RAM to the memory card or vice versa
- Moved bible(s) in another folder of the memory card

3. Choose Bible version
 - Tap on the desired Bible version in the options list

Gray status of a version indicates one of the following:

- Bible version is not installed (if you have installed a Bible version after the last scan, scan again)
- Bible is selected as **Complimentary Book** (see section 6.2)
- Versions of the Bible are not synchronized. To download latest versions, please, visit our website:
www.gmpsoft.com

4. Confirm
 - Tap on **Done** button

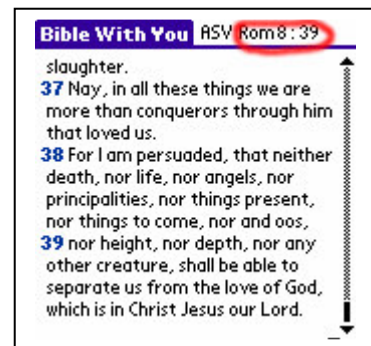
5.2 Navigate in the Bible

1. Read a chapter
 - Use the scroll bar to move the text up and down

The Menu Bar displays the active verse. *Active verse* is the one that is displayed in the menu bar.

2. Activate a verse
 - Tap on the desired verse in the text

The active verse will move at the top of the text area.
3. Move the text up and down by pages
 - Use **Page Up/Page Down** buttons of your handheld

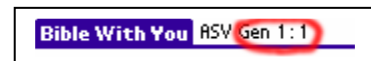


5.3 Select a book, chapter and/or verse

Selection order is from a more general to more specific object (for example, when you choose a book, the application will open the **Select Verse** form. Then, when you choose a chapter, the **Select Verse** form will be opened). To exit the selection order, tap on **OK** button.

Important: You can change Bible version, book, chapter and verse by tapping on the respective active field in the **Select Book/Select Chapter/Select Verse** forms.

1. Open the **Select Book/Select Chapter/Select Verse** form
 - Tap on the *book abbreviation* or *chapter/verse number* field in the *Menu Bar*.

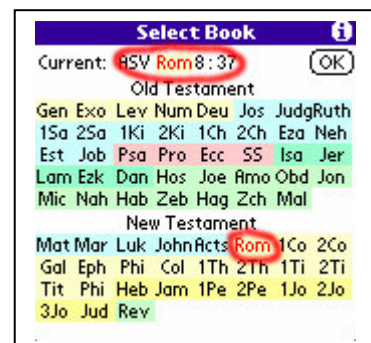


2. Select a book
 - Tap on a book abbreviation in the **Select Book** form

Red font indicates current book

2.1 Confirm current selection

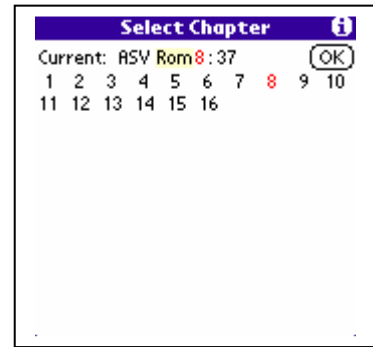
- Tap on **OK** button



3. Select a chapter

- Tap on the desired number in the list

Red font indicates current chapter number



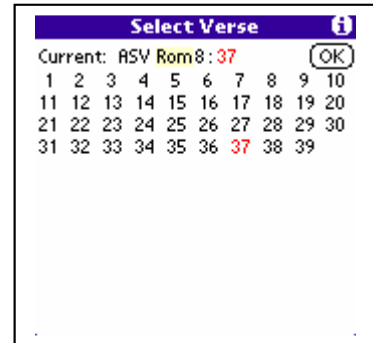
3.1 Confirm current selection

- Tap on **OK** button

4. Select a verse

- Tap on the respective number in the list

Red font indicates verse number



4.1 Confirm current selection

- Tap on **OK** button

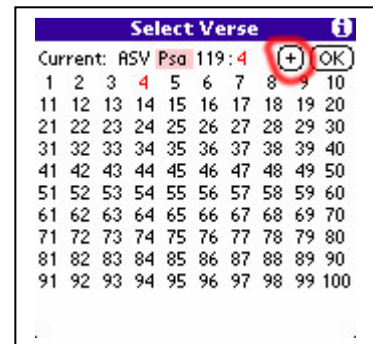
Important: If the number of chapters or verses is more than one hundred they will be displayed in two forms

5. View more chapter or verse numbers

- Tap on '+' button

6. View smaller chapter or verse numbers

- Tap on '-' button



5.4 See verse in another Bible Translation

1. Select another Bible translation

- Follow the instructions described in section 4.1

The verse will be automatically displayed in the other Bible translation.

5.5 Copying Verses

Bible With You allows you to copy a single verse or whole chapter to paste in another applications.

5.5.1 Copy Active Verse

Allow you to copy only the current active verse.

1. Activate a verse

- Tap on the desired verse in the text

Or

- Select it as in **5.3 Select a book, chapter and/or verse**

Active verse is the one that is displayed in the menu bar.
Scrolling the text does not change the active verse.

2. Choose **Copy Active Verse** from the **Edit** menu:

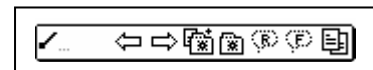
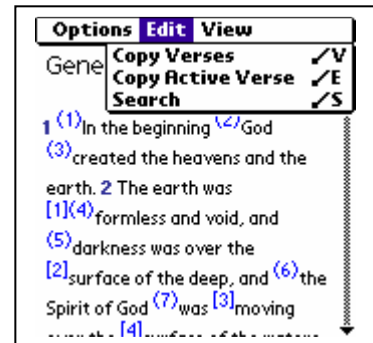
- Tap on **Bible With You** bar or **Menu** button to display the form menu
- Tap on **Edit**
- Tap on **Copy Active Verse**

Or

- Draw the *Graffiti Menu Command stroke* to display the command toolbar
- Tap on the *Copy* icon

Or

- Draw the *Graffiti Menu Command stroke* ✓ and the letter **E** on the silkscreen



5.5.2 Copy Verses

This option allows you to copy all verses from the current selection – whole chapter or number of references displayed.

Warning: You could have problems pasting larger passages in some applications (for example, *Memo Pad*).

1. Choose **Copy Verses** from the **Edit** menu:

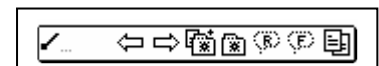
- Tap on **Bible With You** bar or **Menu** button to display the form menu
- Tap on **Edit**
- Tap on **Copy Verses**

Or

- Draw the *Graffiti Menu Command stroke* to display the command toolbar
- Tap on the *Copy* icon

Or

- Draw the *Graffiti Menu Command stroke* ✓ and the letter **V** on the silkscreen



5.6 Search for words in the Bible

Bible With You does not support its own search engine. However, it is closely integrated to Concordance With You. It allows you to perform fast *On tap* search, search in selected parts of the Bible, view results with verse excerpts for fast orientation and the number of matches. For more information and downloads, please, visit our website: www.gmpsoft.com.

The Search Feature of Bible With You is realized by launching Concordance With You, which supports Show Verse Protocol (See Section 8).

1. Choose **Search** from the **Edit** menu
 - Tap on **Bible With You** bar or **Menu** button to display the form menu
 - Tap on **Edit**
 - Tap on **Search**

Or

 - Draw the *Graffiti Menu Command stroke* ✓ and the letter **S** on the silkscreen

5.7 History

Bible With You keeps history of the passages you have visited allowing you to move back and forward in the history list.

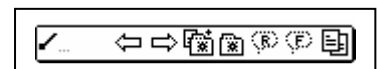
1. Go to previous passage
 - Tap on **Bible With You** bar or **Menu** button to display the form menu
 - Tap on **View**
 - Tap on **Previous**

Or

 - Draw the *Space Graffiti Stroke* on the *silk screen*

Or

 - Draw the *Graffiti Menu Command stroke* to display the command toolbar
 - Tap on the *Back arrow*



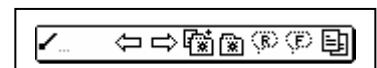
2. Go to the next passage in history
 - Tap on **Bible With You** bar or **Menu** button to display the form menu
 - Tap on **View**
 - Tap on **Next**

Or

 - Draw the *Backspace Graffiti Stroke* on the *silk screen*

Or

 - Draw the *Graffiti Menu Command stroke* to display the command toolbar
 - Tap on the *Back arrow*



6 Comparing Bibles mode

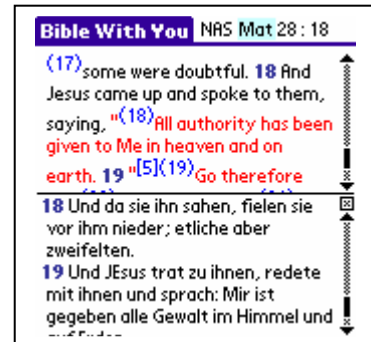
You can read and compare verses in two Bible versions. In order to use this option you need to install at least two bibles. More bibles are available at www.gmpsoft.com.

The screen in *comparison mode* is split in two and the two bible versions are displayed parallel in the sections of the screen.

6.1 Select Bible for the upper window

1. Same as *Select Bible version*
 - See section 5.1 for instructions

The *Menu Bar* indicates the Bible version in the upper window

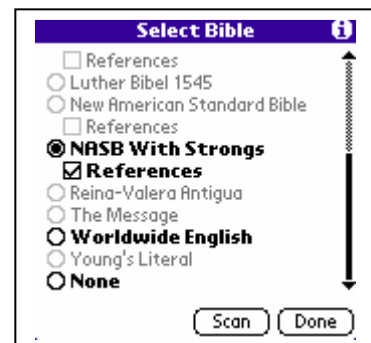


6.2 Select Bible for the bottom window

1. Same as *Select Bible version*, but choose **Complimentary Book** from the **Options** menu.
 - See section 5.1 for instructions**Or**
 - Draw the *Graffiti Menu Command stroke* ✓ and the letter **C** on the silkscreen

Choosing a Bible for the bottom window automatically sets the *Comparing Bibles Mode*

Choosing **None** will return the application to *Reading Bible Mode*.



6.3 Navigate in the text

1. Move the text
 - Use the respective scroll bar to move the text up and down in each window.



The *Menu Bar* displays the active verse

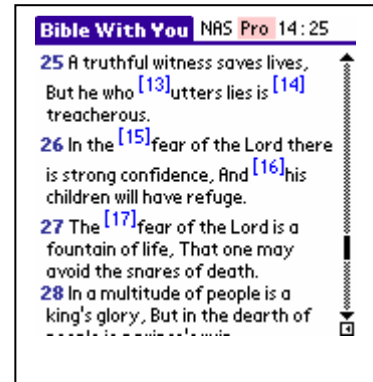


2. Synchronize a verse in both windows by activating it
 - Tap on the verse you want to make active

Both Bibles will synchronically display the active verse at the top of their window

6.4 Hide Complimentary Book

1. Hide *Complimentary Book*
 - Tap on the  button in the *Complimentary Book* window
2. Show *Complimentary Book*
 - Tap on the  button at the bottom of the scroll-bar



6.5 Select a book, chapter and/or verse to compare

3. Same as in *Reading Bible Mode*
 - Follow the instructions in section 5.3

Selected verse will be synchronically displayed by both bible versions

6.6 Return to Reading Bible Mode

1. Choose **Complimentary Book** from the **Options** menu:
 - Tap on **Bible With You** bar or **Menu** button to display the form menu
 - Tap on **Options**
 - Tap on **Complimentary Book**
2. Deselect bible version:
 - Choose **None** from the list
3. Confirm
 - Tap on **Done** button

7 Bible Study Aids


7.1 Bookmarks

Allows you to manage and store your favorite passages as Bookmarks.

7.1.1 Add a bookmark

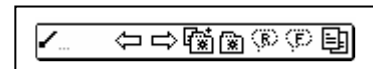
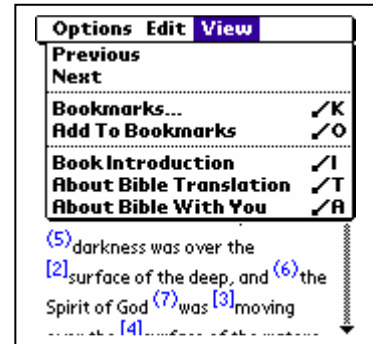
1. Go to the desired verse(s)
 - See 5.2 to learn how
2. Choose **Add to Bookmarks** from the **Edit** menu:
 - Tap on **Bible With You** bar or **Menu** button to display the form menu
 - Tap on **Edit**
 - Tap on **Add to Bookmarks**

Or

- Draw the *Graffiti Menu Command stroke* to display the command toolbar
- Tap on the *Add to Bookmarks* icon 

Or

- Draw the *Graffiti Menu Command stroke* ✓ and the letter **O**



7.1.2 Manage Bookmarks

1. Choose **Bookmarks** from the **Edit** menu:
 - Tap on **Bible With You** bar or **Menu** button to display the form menu
 - Tap on **Edit**
 - Tap on **Bookmarks**

Or

- Draw the *Graffiti Menu Command stroke* to display the command toolbar
- Tap on the *Bookmarks* icon 

Or

- Draw the *Graffiti Menu Command stroke* ✓ and the letter **K**

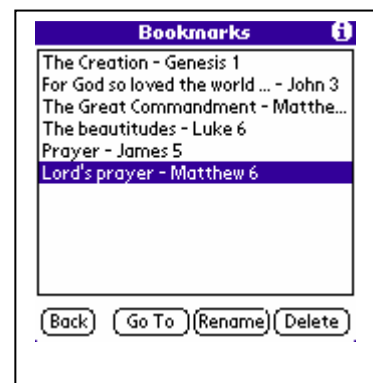
Note: You need to have at least one bookmark in order to open the **Bookmarks** form.

2. Select a bookmark
 - Tap on it in the list

3. View a bookmark
 - Tap on **Go To**

Or

- Tap on it again



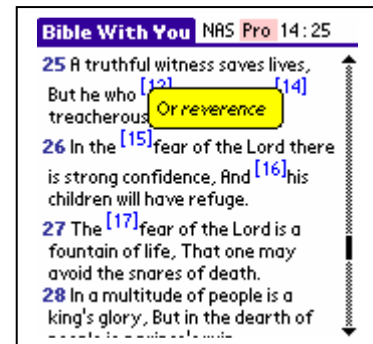
4. Rename a bookmark
By default, Bookmarks are entitled by the respective bible book and chapter number.
➤ Tap on **Rename**
5. Delete a bookmark
➤ Tap on **Delete**
6. Exit to Bible text
➤ Tap on **Back**

7.2 Footnotes

Bible With You implements the footnotes available in some of the biblical databases.

For more convenience the footnotes are displayed as pop-ups and not below the text.

1. Show footnote
➤ Tap on the footnote number in square brackets in superscript
2. Close footnote
➤ Tap inside the footnote pop-up or anywhere on the screen

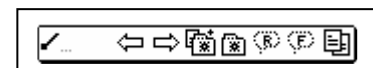


7.3 Cross References

Bible With You implements the cross references available in some bible translations. **Bible References** is a separate GMP Soft product available only for some of the bibles. For more information, view Bible Study Aids on GMP Soft Products page (<http://www.gmpsoft.com>).

References are displayed as pop-ups.

1. Activate/Hide cross reference
➤ Read the instructions in the User Guide of **Bible References**
Or
➤ Draw the *Graffiti Menu Command stroke* to display the command toolbar
➤ Tap on **F** icon



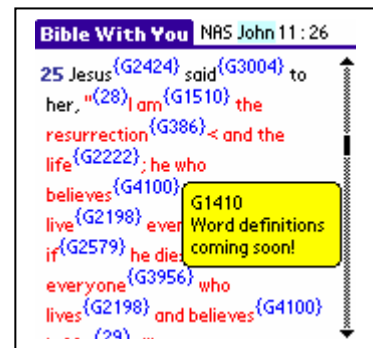
2. Show cross reference
 - Tap on the reference number marked in round brackets in superscript
3. View passages in a reference
 - Tap on the text in the reference pop-up
4. Close pop-up with cross references
 - Tap on a blank space inside the reference

7.4 Strong's Numbers

Bible With You visualizes the *Strong's numbers* and *definitions* available for NASB bible. To use Strong's numbers, you need to install **Bible With You** for a translation that supports them.

The feature allows you to view *Strong's numbers* and *definitions* of the original words in pop-up windows.

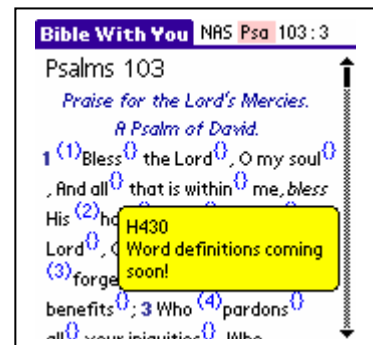
Strong's numbers are indicated by *braces* in the text. Choose between displaying numbers in the text and displaying only the **Marks** (Braces).



1. Select *Show/Hide Strong's Numbers/Marks*
 - Adjust **Show Strong's Numbers/Marks** in **Preferences** form (see section 4)
- Or
 - Draw the *Graffiti Menu Command stroke* to display the command toolbar
- Tap on the **S** icon to alternatively display **Strong's numbers** in the text, show only **Marks** (braces) or hide Strong's numbers.



2. View Strong's numbers and definitions
 - Tap on the **Strong's number** inside the braces or, if only **Marks** are displayed, inside the braces.
3. Close pop-up with definition
 - Tap inside the pop-up



7.5 Book Introductions

Bible With You implements the *Introductions* to the books of the Bible, available for some bible translations.

1. Display Introduction to a book
 - Go to a bible book (view section 5.3 for instructions)
 - Tap on **Bible With You** bar or **Menu** button to display the form menu
 - Tap on **View**
 - Tap on **Book Introduction**

Or

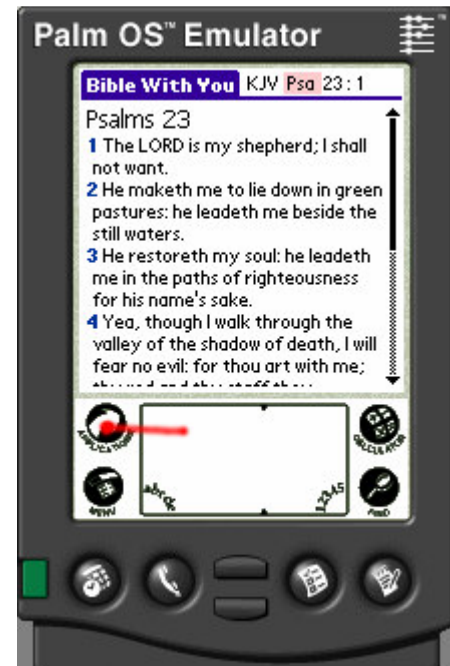
 - Draw the *Graffiti Menu Command stroke* ✓ and the letter **I**



8 Show Verse Protocol

Bible With You supports Show Verse Protocol. It allows other applications to start Bible With You. Afterwards, the user can return to the launcher application.

1. Return to launcher application
 - Tap on the Application Icon and drag the stylus to the right
