Lines is exciting and simple game which has a variety of colors. It has two levels of difficulty that can suit the taste and abilities of everybody.

Included in this archive are the following packages:

app.ppc_arm.CAB, app.ppc_arm2002.CAB, app.ppc30_mips.CAB, app.ppc30_sh3.CAB, Setup.ini, Setup.exe. This is the software package that you need to install on your Pocket PC and after that run Setup.exe.

Lines_PocketPC.pdf – This is the User's Manual for Lines. You are reading it right now.

Registering Lines

The game Lines is downloadable shareware. Its registered copy costs \$9.95.

The demo version is completely functional but with the unregistered version you can play only the easy level of the game. After purchasing the product, you will receive a registration key and the restrictions will disappear.


v.1.10 – Improved game play.

The Goal

The aim of the game is to score points by aligning balls of the same color. When five or more balls of one and the same color are aligned vertically, horizontally or diagonally they disappear. You get points for this (the points you get are equal to the number of aligned balls).

Start

Start the **File Explorer** and then go to **My Device/ Program Files/Games/Webvisia Lines** and tap on the name of the game. The game has two levels of difficulty – easy and hard.



New Game

To start a new game go to **File|New Game**. Choose the level that best suits your skills and then tap **Easy** or **Hard** to play the game.

The Sound Option

You can turn on/off the sound by tapping the button next to the menu ‘**Tools**’.



Choose Your Level

Lines has two difficulty levels – easy and hard. The difference is in the number of balls in the store, which is two or three for each level respectively.

Choose the level that best suits your skills and tap **Easy** or **Hard** to play the game.

Play Lines

The Line Balls

The game has seven different colored balls.



The Store


The store is in the right part of the field and contains two or three balls which will appear in the next turn.

Play Lines

The Lines' playing field contains 81 squares with particular number of balls, depending on the difficulty of the level you are playing. The game goes in turns. Each turn two or three balls of random color appear on random places on the field.

You can then move one ball by selecting it and pointing its destination. The figure can move only in horizontal and vertical direction, through unoccupied fields only. If you manage to arrange five or more balls with the same color in a line (horizontal, vertical or diagonal) they disappear from the field and your score increases. Longer lines are scored higher.

You can use the **Undo** button to go back to the previous turn. If you have made ten or more turns you can use the **Undo** button maximum ten times. You can not use the **Undo** button if you have arranged a line in the previous turn.



Game Over!

When a game is completed a Game Over screen appears. Tap anywhere on the display to return to the main screen.



Congratulations!

Congratulations! You are one of the top! If you have gained high score your result will be one of the best. The following dialog will appear:



Enter your name for the record and tap **OK** to continue. Alternatively, tap **Cancel** to move on to the next game.
